## What Is PeDRA?

The Pediatric Dermatology Research Alliance (PeDRA) is a collaborative research network, providing a platform for scientists in the field of pediatric dermatology to collaborate and conduct research. As of October 2019, PeDRA includes more than 280 scientists across more than 130 institutions as well as patient advocacy organizations, industry partners, and other supporters committed to improving the lives of children with all skin diseases through research. PeDRA works by identifying important research questions within its network, providing centralized support and funding that helps research studies succeed, and building an empowered community through conferences and education.
