Researchers at the University of Wisconsin - Madison want to understand why people get these severe burn-like skin reactions following infections so that we can better treat them and prevent them from recurring.

We are seeking individuals of any age who has had one of these severe skin reactions to better understand the causes. We hope to improve care and develop new treatments for others affected by these same conditions.

This study involves:

- optional saliva or tissue sample
- no in-person visit

RESEARCHERS

This is a state-of-the-art multi-center investigation of these infectious mucocutaneous eruptions, involving prospective data and DNA collection, comprehensive phenotyping, and a pilot analysis of exome sequencing.
