



PRESIDENT'S LETTER

Dear Friends,

It's tempting to suggest 2023 was a year like any other. The fanfare of our 10th anniversary in 2022 had subsided, the intensity of the COVID-19 pandemic was fading, and PeDRA had a full year to grind away on routine business. Yet in the end, our 2023 impact was far from routine. Thanks to the dedication, creativity, and hard work of our leaders, members, collaborators, and staff, 2023 was a year full of novelty and accomplishment. We advanced the field and strengthened PeDRA's capacity to make an impact on patients whose lives we strive to improve through research.

Three highlights from 2023 excite me the most. They demonstrate PeDRA's capacity to react quickly, to offer appreciation of our evolving community, and to operate thoughtfully in support of long-term objectives.

First, in 2022 we identified a need to offer short-term mentored research opportunities to medical students from diverse backgrounds who might otherwise be unable to gain experience in the field. In response we mobilized four PeDRA committees, secured funding from two industry allies, and launched the Emerging Investigator Research Grant program less than six months later. In the program's first year we gave an astonishing 10 grants.

Second, to recognize outstanding contributions from individuals who make up the fabric of our community, we launched the PeDRA Awards Program. I was thrilled by the health of the process to nominate and select awardees and the strengths of our first Volunteer of the Year, Mentor of the Year, and Community Member of the Year.

Finally, in 2023 PeDRA implemented a set of core values centered on integrity, collaboration, mentorship, curiosity, innovation, equity, diversity, and inclusion, and patient-centricity. While I've always taken pride in our community's ability to pursue its mission without needing a recipe for success, the core value statements resonate deeply with what I believe PeDRA to be and will provide a firm foundation for PeDRA's efforts for many years to come.




